Tennessee Valley Kennel Club, Inc. (TVKC) will host its annual shows on November 4-5. Once again these events return to a very popular previous venue: Chilhowee Park. All judging will be indoors, where facilities have been recently upgraded. Local competitors and those from all over the country are anticipating a fun weekend of dog shows.

Conformation (breed), obedience and rally will all be offered. In addition to the all-breed competition, there are supported entries on both days by the Siberian Husky Club of Middle TN and the East TN Collie Club. Those breeds should be represented by a larger than average turnout.

In addition to the formal competitions, there are other events of interest to dog lovers and those just beginning to compete. On Friday, starting at 6:30 pm, an all-breed sanctioned match will be held in the Jacobs Building. On Saturday evening, the rally ring will be available for rental (\$5 per 10 minutes). There's also a cardiology screening on Sunday, 10-3:30, by Dr. Rebecca Gompf, DACVIM, of
